Length: 4 hours

Description: This four hour session provides selected managers with skills and strategies for holding discussions on the three modules (Connecting with People, Connecting with Technology, and Connecting with Safety) with managers at the facility level. 4-hour sessions for managers will be conducted at 35-40 major metropolitan areas by a cadre of facilitators to include Directors. They will be scheduled between June - October, 2009.

Leading Edge Forum 2.0 – Making the Connection with Employees

Course #: FAA60000054

Length: 1.5 hours (3 30 min. segments)

Description: This course consists of three modules: Connecting with People, Connecting with Technology, and Connecting with Safety. Short videos will be presented and accompanied by written material and an opportunity for dialogue and input. The three modules can be presented together or separately. It is recommended that the modules be delivered monthly, and should be completed by December 31, 2009.
